Christmas Lights

Dear Residents,

We are fast approaching the Christmas season and would like to ask for your help in making the development look as wonderfully festive as possible.

For a Christmas effect on arrival into the development, there will be nets of lights on the bushes on the lead up to the security gates, as well as up to the first roundabout. Taking on board feedback over the years, warm white is the colour that will be used throughout.

There will also be the lights in St Martin's Lane square, which were kindly funded by residents last year.

Would you be able to sponsor, or donate towards, a festive lamp post? With extra funding, it would also be possible to adorn all lamp posts with lights, giving a festive feel throughout the development. To do this, we need to fit power sockets to approx. 35 lampposts (6 of them already have one) and buy the lights. This would be £120-125 per lamppost.

We will try to fund any shortfall to do as many lamp post as we can from LPRA funds.

Quotes from local companies last year were in the several thousands and a number of residents expressed they would be willing to help to keep costs low. We'd be delighted to have more volunteers to get the lights up faster!
